Everything is free of charge.

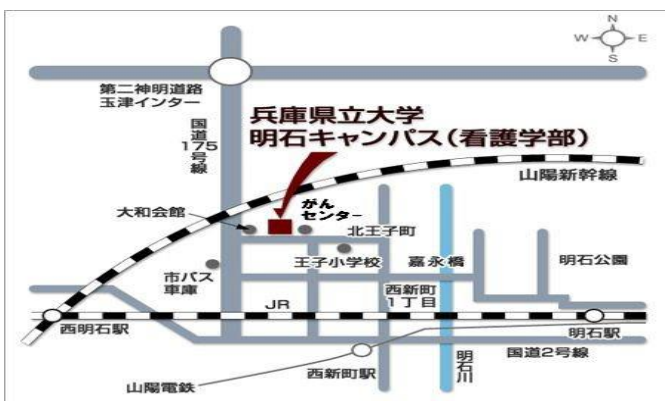
